### RESOLUTION #1741 - APPROVAL OF JULY 1, 2018-JUNE 30, 2019 AUDIT AND SUBMITTAL TO HUD FOR APPROVAL

BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the Town of Phillipsburg hereby certifies to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that each governing body member has personally reviewed the annual audit report for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2019 and, specifically, has reviewed the sections of the audit report entitled "General Comments and Recommendation", and has evidenced same by group affidavit in the form prescribed by the Local Finance Board. *Commissioner Decker* moved to adopt Resolution #1741, which motion was seconded by *Commissioner Corcoran*.
